# Spanair

## **Applies to Options, Policies**

The following news report was supplied by <u>www.stuff.co.nz</u> on 29/01/2012:

"Spain's government has launched legal action against the now-defunct airline Spanair for allegedly violating the country's aviation regulations by suddenly ceasing operations, a minister said on Saturday.

An estimated 22,000 passengers who had booked seats on more than 220 cancelled flights have been left looking for alternative arrangements and instructions on how to seek reimbursements. Spanair, owned by a consortium based in the north eastern region of Catalonia, shut down its operations late on Friday because of a lack of funding."

International Passenger Protection London has subsequently withdrawn cover for this airline with immediate effect.

### Cover for Spanair is withdrawn for all policies purchased on or after 30<sup>th</sup> January 2012.

Please also note that exclusion 2 under Section 1 – Travel Services Provider Insolvency, of our Options Policies states:

We Will Not Pay For:

2. Insolvency of a Travel Services Provider if at the Relevant Time, the Travel Services Provider was Insolvent or a reasonable person would have reason to expect the Travel Services Provider might become Insolvent.

"Relevant Time" in respect of:

- a) Single Trip policies means the issue date of the policy.
- b) Annual Multi-Trip means the first time at which any part of the relevant trip is paid for or the time at which the policy is issued, whichever occurs last.

As the possibility now exists that the airline may become insolvent, cover under the Insolvency benefit has been withdrawn.
